HELLO, MONTAGUE!

It's hard to believe that we're already half-way through summer!

The libraries have been busy behind the scenes. Three new trustees, Miryam, David, and Louisa, were voted onto the board this summer and have hit the ground running; joining committees and getting acquainted with MPL priorities, plans, and policies.

Last month, the trustees voted to approve the hiring of Barbara Friedman, former director of the Erving Public Library, to serve as the Libraries' consultant for the Massachusetts Public Library Construction Program application. Barbara will use her experience and expertise to gather public feedback that will inform our library building program. This document records everything that our community wants to see in their public library. Over the next few months, Barbara will create a survey, facilitate public forums, and do outreach in the community so we can make sure that we include diverse perspectives and needs in our final plan. Stay tuned for information about coming public forums.

MPL is also excited to announce that our libraries have been selected to participate in the American Library Association's Great Stories Club, a book club for teens that will be facilitated at the Brick House, the high school, and at the Montague Libraries starting this fall. Not your everyday book club, this program will feature book discussion AND art making.
