The displayed key was used for which building?</b></p>	<p><b>Go to the Carnegie Local History room and find a business directory from the 1920s. Where could you have gone to buy ice cream in Turners Falls?</b></p>
<p><b>Go to the Montague Center Branch and find plate 4152 in "Views of Montague Homes &amp; Residents: Book 1." Who was the postmaster from 1915-1935?</b></p>	<p><b>Go to the Millers Falls Branch and look through the "Early Plates of Millers Falls" photo binder. What was the address of the Teahan's House?</b></p>	<p><b>Go to the Montague Historical Society website and find the document about the first flights at Rock Dam Field (<a href="http://montaguearchive.org">montaguearchive.org</a>). In what year did Willard make these flights?</b></p>
<p><b>Go to Unity Park and read about the Building Bridges mural (west/right side of field house; info also online at <a href="http://nolumbekaproject.org">nolumbekaproject.org</a>). What is depicted in the panel by Nohham R. Cachat-Schilling?</b></p>	<p><b>Find the Rock Paper Knife art piece along the bike path (behind Town Hall) and read the plaque. Where was the stacked paper in the piece produced?</b></p>	<p><b>Go to the Great Falls Discovery Center and find the Dinosaur footprints panel. How many dinosaurs' footprints are identified on the rock?</b></p>
